## Martin Luther King Jr. Day Is January 21

Martin Luther King Jr., born January 15, 1929, was an American Baptist minister and activist who became the most visible spokesperson and leader in the civil rights movement from 1954 until his death in 1968. King is best known for advancing civil rights through non-violence and civil disobedience.



King helped organize the 1963 March on Washington, where he delivered his famous "I Have a Dream" speech. On October 14, 1964, King won the Nobel Peace Prize for combating racial inequality through nonviolent resistance. King was assassinated on April 4, 1968, in Memphis, Tennessee.

On November 2, 1983, President Ronald Reagan signed a bill to create a federal holiday honoring King. The Martin Luther King Jr. Memorial on the National Mall in Washington, D.C., was dedicated in 2011.

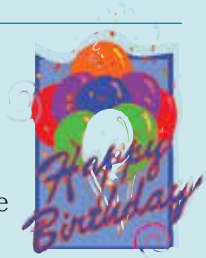
