The origins of Mother's Day in the United States date back to the 19th century. In 1870, Julia Ward Howe wrote the "Mother's Day Proclamation," a call to action that asked mothers to unite in promoting world peace.

Cinco de Mayo, the fifth of May, is a holiday that celebrates the date of the Mexican army's May 5, 1862, victory over France at the Battle of Puebla during the Franco-Mexican War. It has evolved into a celebration of Mexican culture and heritage.



MEMORIAL DAY

Memorial Day, originally called Decoration Day, was first observed on May 30, 1868, at Arlington National Cemetery when flowers were placed on the graves of fallen Union and Confederate soldiers. It became an official federal holiday in 1971, honoring men and women who died while serving in the U.S. military.
