#### Health Talk with Nurse DeDe

I thought we would talk about seasonal allergies, also called hay fever. What are seasonal allergies? They come from an allergic reaction to the growth cycle for plants and mold. As they grow, plants and mold release pollen and spores into the air. When you breathe in pollen and spores, it can cause inflammation, irritation and other symptoms.

#### Here are some common seasonal allergy signs and symptoms:

- Itchy, watery or red eyes
- Circles under eyes
- Itchy mouth, nose or throat
- Runny or stuffy nose
- Drainage from the nose down the back of the throat (postnasal drip)
- Temporary loss of smell
- Headache, sneezing, dry cough
- Tiredness (due to difficulty sleeping from other symptoms)
- Scratchy or sore throat (rarely)
- Snoring (due to congestion)

How do you know if you have seasonal allergies? Talk with your primary care doctor or clinician. An allergy specialist can provide an official allergy diagnosis.

What causes seasonal allergies? Pollen is a powdery substance produced by trees, grasses and weeds as part of their reproductive cycle. Mold typically appears as black, white or green splotches on damp surfaces. It commonly grows in bathrooms and basements but can be on fallen wet leaves and plants.

Get the care you need to keep seasonal allergies under control.

Over-the -counter allergy medications work reasonably well, especially for itching and sneezing. But make sure you continue to take your allergy medication consistently and as directed to help maintain that relief throughout the allergy season.
